

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

## TRANSPORT

Parking: We have free parking available onsite for all ticket holders. Cars can be left here overnight but must be picked up by 3pm Sunday afternoon.

Ubers: We get Uber service here so this is a highly recommended means of transport both to and from the venue.

Buses: These will be made available depending on your area. Please email [sarah@turangacreek.co.nz](mailto:sarah@turangacreek.co.nz) with your drop off area and ticket purchase number and we will confirm with you if we get enough interest to run these. There will be an extra charge for these but we will run them at full capacity for those areas that have high demand. Buses will aim to arrive at the venue by 1pm and will leave by 8.30pm after the event has concluded.

## ENTRANCE

Every adult needs a ticket which can be purchased online at Eventfinda. Kids 14 & under are free. You can print your ticket or have it available on your phone/device - we just need to be able to scan the QR code.

Every adult ticket includes a PET plastic (100% recyclable) glass which they will use at the bar for purchasing alcoholic beverages.

Gate sales are unlikely to be available as the event is likely to sell out ahead of time.

You can bring most items inside including food but there is no BYO of beverages of any kind including water (unless sealed). Gazebos, chairs, blankets, umbrellas...etc. are all welcome.

## INSIDE THE EVENT

There will be a variety of food trucks available to purchase food from. These will be confirmed and announced via social media, our website and Eventfinda.

Free tap water will be available throughout the event at multiple sites including next to the bar - look for signs.

If you want to sell your ticket due to unforeseen circumstances we suggest contacting Eventfinda. Previous years people have tried to resell to people in the community (as tickets tend to sell out) but there is the possibility of scammers on Facebook pages. We are not handling refunds or resales.

The event will continue in all weathers when possible - rain will not put us off! If it may rain you are more than welcome to bring tents, gumboots...etc. as the venue is outdoors on a sloping paddock.

Hopefully we won't have restrictions imposed due to Covid19 but in this case all tickets will be valid for the 2022 concert.

There will be a variety of wine, beer, cocktails and non-alcoholics available for purchase. To keep everyone safe all drinks will be poured into your PET plastic glass that you receive on entry - don't lose this as you'll have to buy one for \$3. There's no bottle sales to avoid the hazard of glass but customers can purchase glasses of 300ml of wine (almost half a bottle of wine) so you won't need to keep coming back too often ;)
